- Provide training, providing testbed, developed milestones per industry group through TF on IPv4 address exhaustion (JPNIC)
- Research project on IPv6 address management (CNNIC)
- APNIC collaborated with NIRs on NRO/APNIC on IANA 10% media campaign, picked up by local media in NIR's economies and shared future plans
- A participant from India shared an echo project on IPv6
