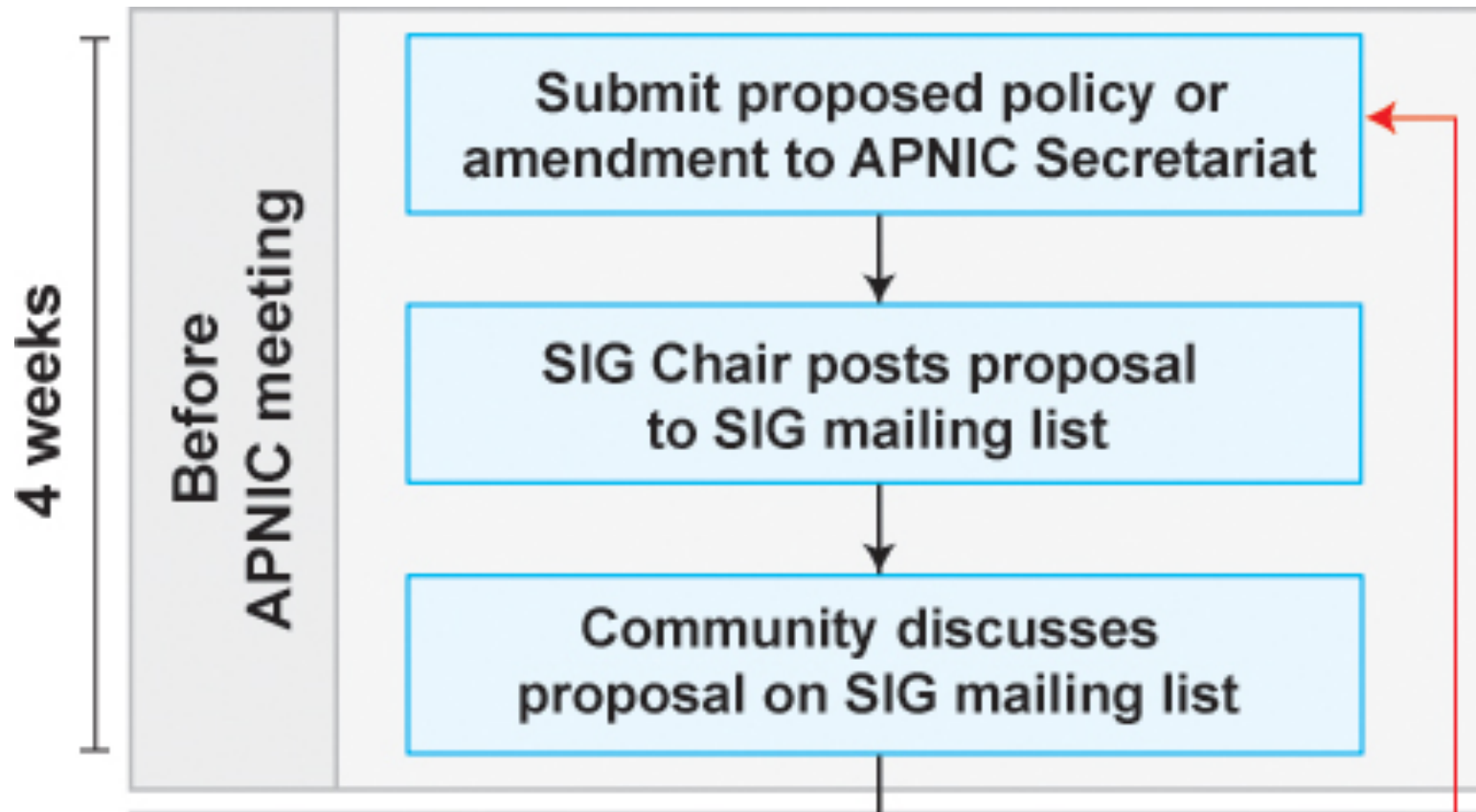


Policy Development Process

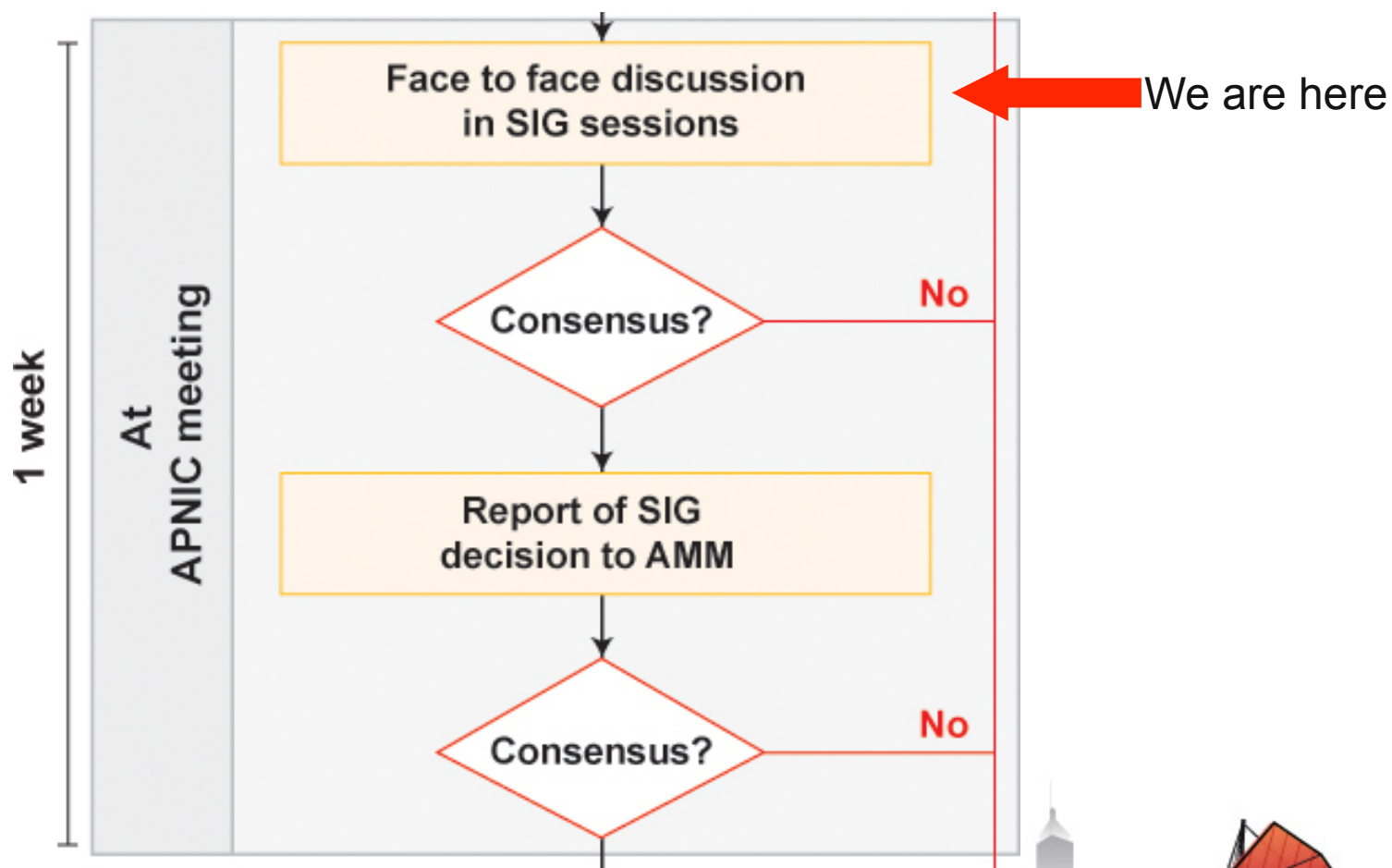

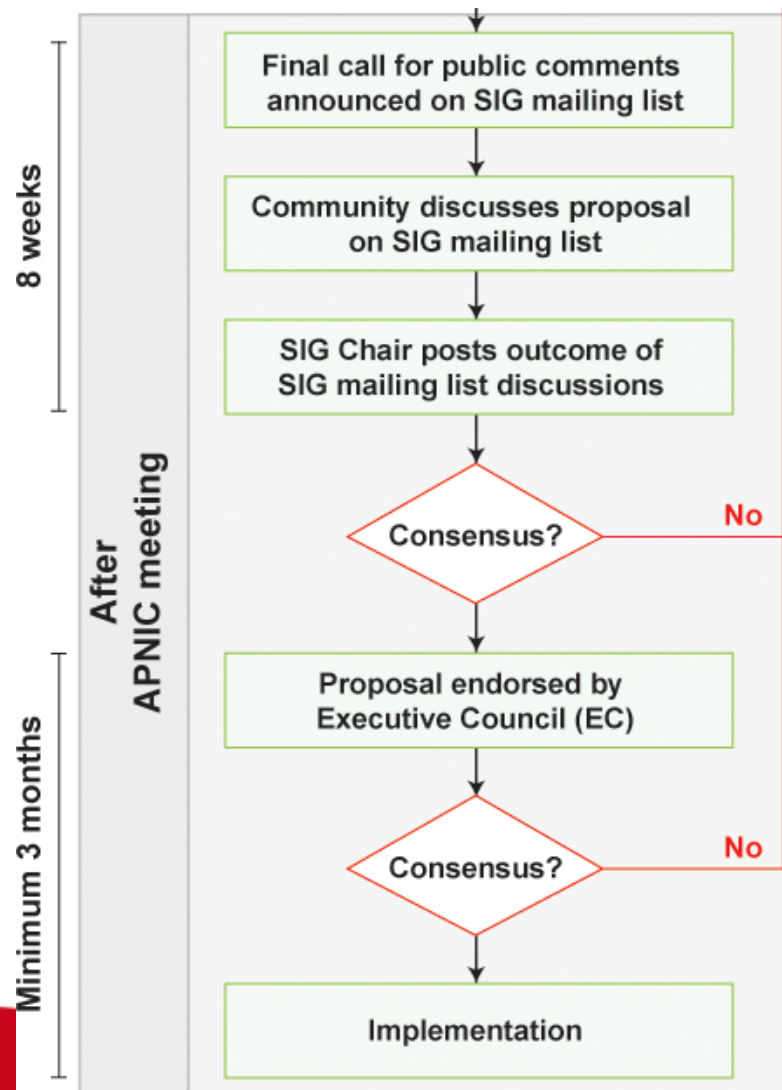
