IPv6 Proposals

- **prop-083:** Alternative criteria for subsequent IPv6 allocations
 - Reached consensus on revised text
- **prop-090:** Optimizing IPv6 allocation strategies
 - No consensus reached
 - Dropped



Last /8 Proposals

- **prop-088:** Distribution of IPv4 addresses once the final /8 period starts
 - Reached consensus
- **prop-092:** Distribution of additional APNIC IPv4 address ranges after IANA exhaustion
 - Failed to reach consensus
 - Dropped
- **prop-091:** Limiting of final /8 policy to specific /9
 - Withdrawn by the author
- **prop-093:** Reducing the minimum delegation size for the final /8 policy
 - Reached consensus



Last /8 Proposals

- **prop-089**: Additional criterion for final /8 allocations (and assignments)
 - Author absent
 - Sent back to mailing list
- **Prop-094**: Adding alternative criteria to renumbering requirement in final /8 policy
 - Reached consensus on revised text



IPv4 IANA Redistribution Global Proposals

- **prop-086:** Global Policy for IPv4 allocations by the IANA post exhaustion
 - Failed to reach consensus
 - Dropped
- **prop-097:** Global Policy for post-exhaustion IPv4 allocation mechanisms by the IANA
 - Reached consensus



Transfer Proposals

- **prop-095**: Inter RIR IPv4 address transfer proposal
 - Reached consensus on revised text
- **prop-096**: Maintaining demonstrated needs requirement in transfer policy after the final /8 phase
 - Failed to reach consensus
 - Sent back to the mailing list
 - Race condition imminent between policy and implementation
