










APNIC Bylaws

Part II.2 – The objects of APNIC are:

- to provide the service of <u>allocating and registering Internet resources for</u> the purpose of enabling communications via open system network protocols and <u>to assist in the development and growth of the Internet in the Asia and Pacific Rim region;</u>
- to assist the Asia and Pacific Rim Internet community in the <u>development of</u> <u>procedures</u>, <u>mechanisms</u>, <u>and standards to efficiently allocate Internet</u> <u>resources</u> as a service to the community as a whole;
- <u>to provide educational opportunities to further Members' technical and policy understanding of the industry;</u>
- to develop public policies and public positions in the best interest of the Members and to seek legislative and regulatory consideration of issues of general benefit to the Members, where and when appropriate;
- to serve as the administrative, managerial and operations arm of APNIC Pty Ltd, and to transact all activities, functions and affairs on behalf, and in the name, of the corporation.

A global, open, stable and secure Internet that serves the entire Asia Pacific community.






